### Fast Swimming

There were three National Age Group and Regional records set over the week end:

James Doolan (Salford) – 17yrs 100 fly  
Chris Walker-Hebborn (Ipswich) – 16yr 100 back  
Myles Crouch Anderson (Northampton) – 14yrs 100 free

In addition, there were two Jersey records set by Katie Speller. From the results, we know that there were several National Qualifying times made by the swimmers. In addition, about 40% of the swims were faster than the entry times. Session 3 had the most proportion of swims faster than the entry times.

### Entries and Withdrawals

Thank you to all the swimmers and coaches who submitted withdrawal forms in advance of the sessions. This helped the meet to run smoothly and minimised the amount of empty lanes during the week end. Hopefully, card-less entries will become the norm.

However, there were still about 110 late withdrawals over the four sessions resulting in some empty lanes. Most were notified in advance and this made it easier for the pool stewards to sort out who was or was not swimming. Perhaps not surprisingly, the last session on the Sunday saw the most "DNC" notes in the results (36!!!).

Advance notice of withdrawals makes it easier to manage a meet and ensures that the event is not longer than it need be!
